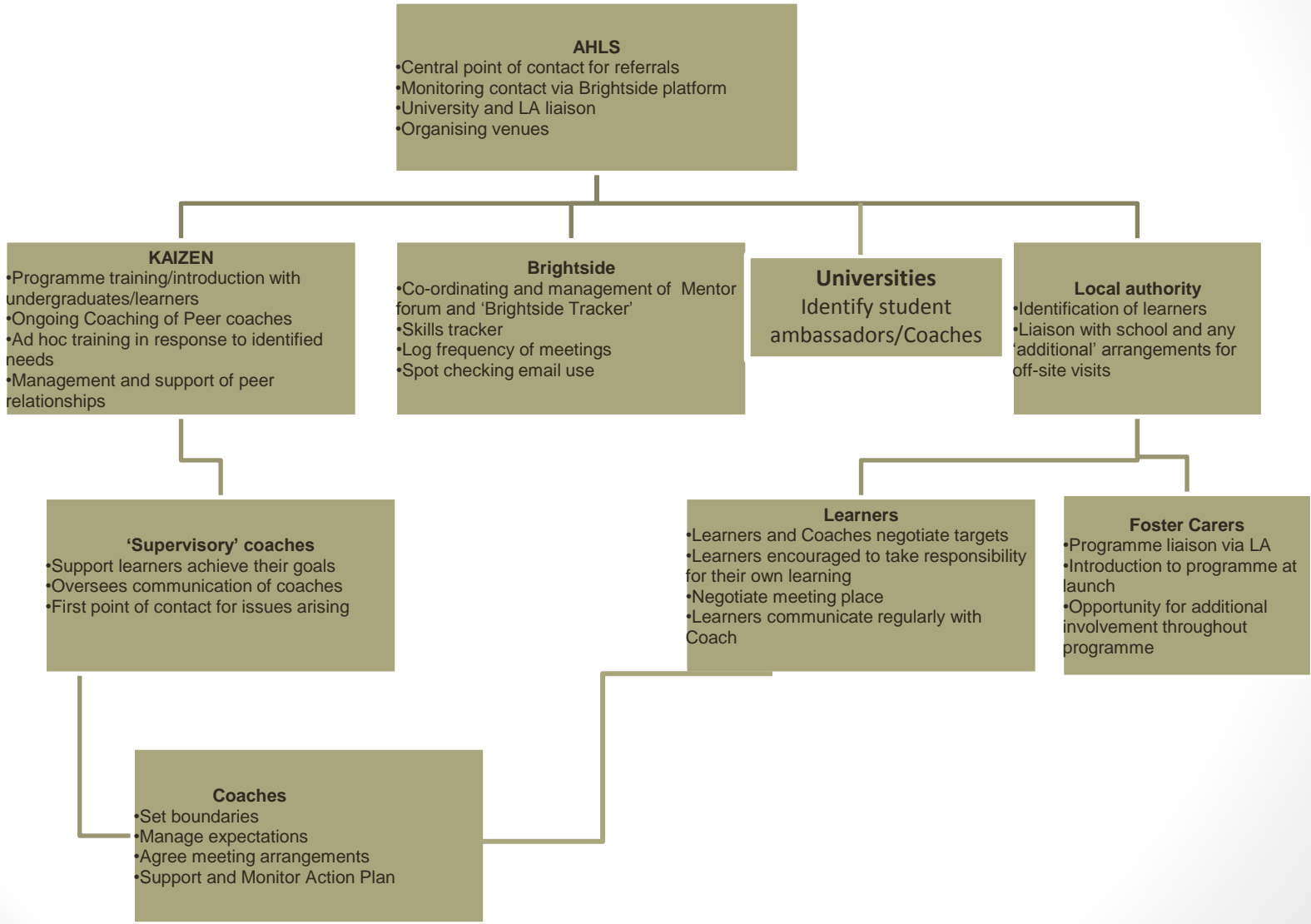

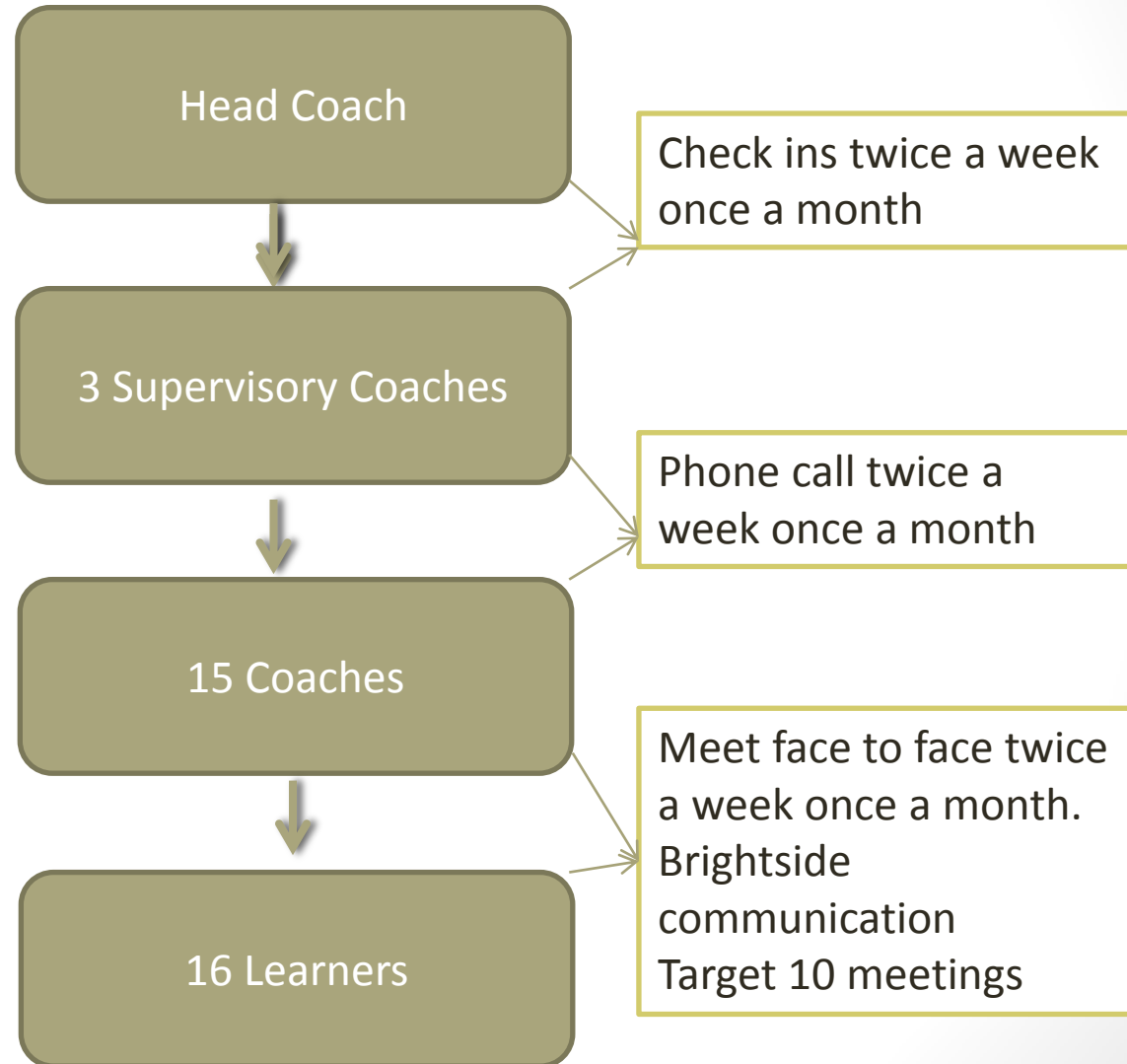

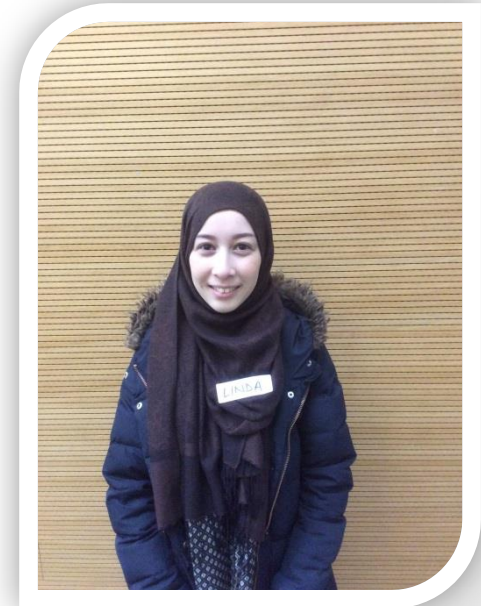

Feedback from Supervisory Coach

"I learnt what coaching is and how to empower others vs 'helping' them. How to not tell others what to do but to allow them to think for themselves. The programme made a big impact on me which I didn't think it would. It made me reflect a lot on myself"

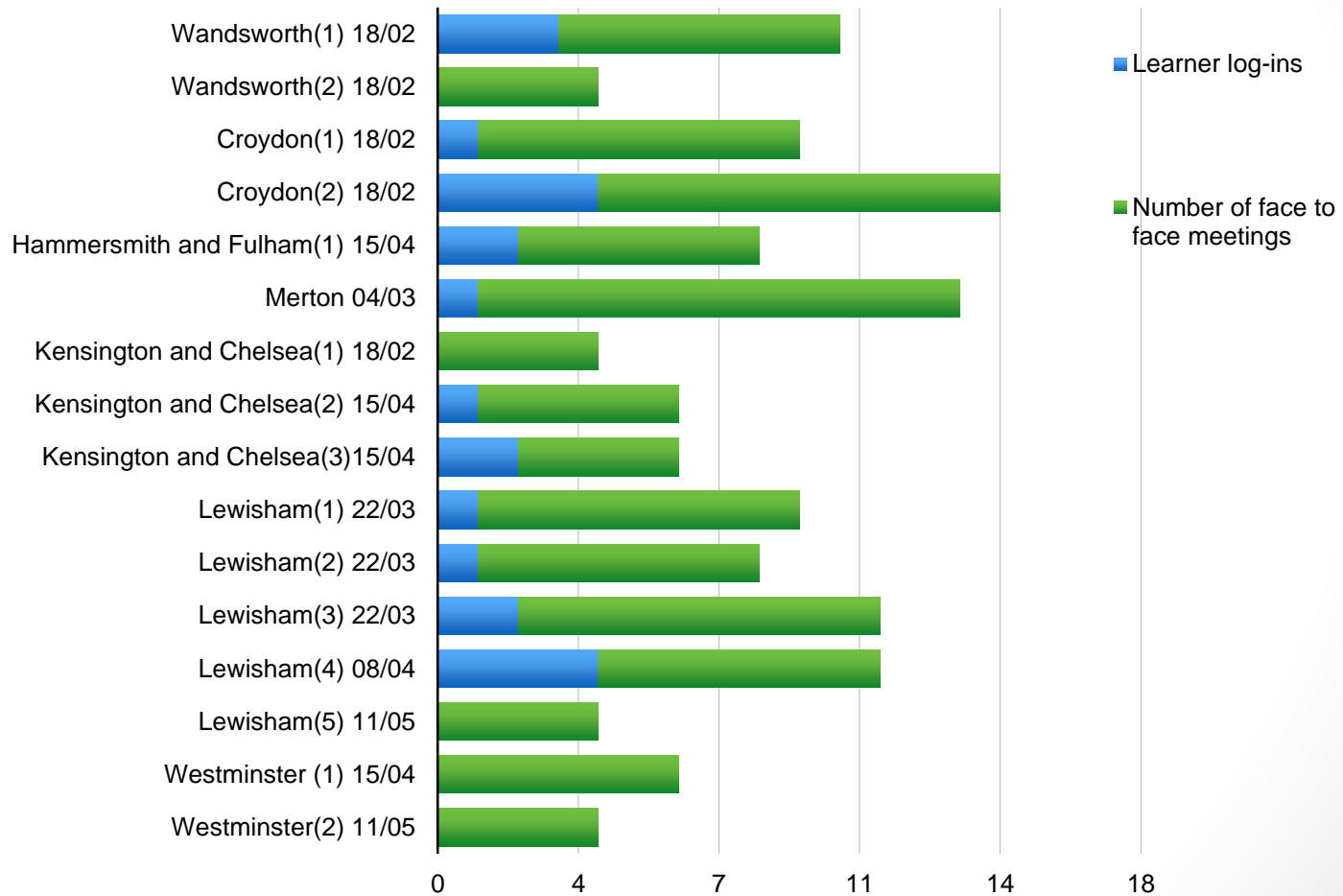


Feedback from Learner
