
#### What is MindManager?

- Available to all LSBU students for download.






### Why use mind mapping? - Uses





Why use mind mapping? - benefits




### Let's get started!

# Select a Map Template to begin your map








#### What's your map going to be about?





#### How to start your Map


- Decide on your Central topic.
- Hit the Enter button to confirm.
- Hit the Enter button again to add a Main topic





#### How to build your map.

- Decide on your Main topics.
- Hit Enter each time to confirm
- Hit Enter again to add other Main topics.





# **Building your map – adding subtopics**


- Add subtopics if you need to.
- Add as many levels as you like no limit.





# Building your map – adding subtopics

- Several ways to add subtopics.
- Right-click, insert tab, insert key.






### Add notes to a topic – extra details

- Use the **Notes** feature to add extra information to a topic.
- Add notes in pane on right of window.


Close – to reopen click the notes icon next to

the topic.





### How to change the look of your map




- Different templates and themes available
  - try them out!
- Go to the **Design** tab
  - have a look at the different themes.



#### How to export your Map


- Go to the File menu.
- Select Export
- Send your map to Word or save it as an image file.
- Save to a USB memory stick or attach to a personal email address.





#### **Export to Word settings**

- Word Export
   Settings dialogue
   box
- Ignore everything...
- ...except maybe
   'Export overview map at beginning of document'
